

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMARILLO, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE VENTURA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 5, 2024, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD THE SAME DATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 10403 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE

The City Council of the City of Camarillo resolves as follows:

SECTION 1: The City Council of the City of Camarillo finds and declares as follows:

A. The City Council of the City of Camarillo called a General Municipal Election to be held November 5, 2024, to elect two Members (District 3 and District 4) to the Camarillo City Council.

B. It is desirable for the General Municipal Election to be consolidated with the Statewide General Election being held on the same date and, that within the city, the precincts, polling places and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the County of Ventura Election Division canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

SECTION 2: Pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General election on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, for the purpose of the election of two Members (District 3 and District 4) to the City Council.

SECTION 3: The City Council acknowledges that the consolidated election will be held and conducted in the manner prescribed in Elections Code Section 10418.

SECTION 4: The County Elections Division is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election and only one form of ballot shall be used.

SECTION 5: The Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Elections Division to take any and all steps necessary for holding the consolidated election.

SECTION 6: The City of Camarillo recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County due to this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any costs.

SECTION 7: The City Clerk is directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Ventura County Elections Division.
