Subject: California Contract Cities Association (CCCA) – Discontinuation of Membership

BACKGROUND

The City of Camarillo is actively involved in local and regional organizations and appoints members of the City Council to a variety of Boards, Commissions, and Committees. The City's participation is essential to staying informed, helps provide a forum to advocate on important issues, and builds a network and connections for resources to better serve our residents and community.

Camarillo is a current member of the California Contract Cities Association with a primary and alternate delegate appointed as representatives.

DISCUSSION

The City is currently members of other various organizations which provide similar support as that of the California Contract Cities Association, and which better serve the City's interests. It is advisable to discontinue the CCCA membership at this time to avoid duplicative memberships and focus advocacy and maximize efforts with organizations that provide larger scale support and coverage to better align with the City's needs.

The Policy Committee at their meeting on October 25, 2023 unanimously recommended the discontinuation of participation and membership on the CCCA.

The City Council has the discretion and right to resume membership at any time, should an issue arise where greater coordination with the CCCA is necessary.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no budget impact as a result of this action.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the discontinuation of membership with the California Contract Cities Association.
