Assembly Bill 2097 Parking Informational Update

Assembly Bill 2097 (AB 2097) was passed by the California Legislature in 2022, went into effect January 1, 2023, and applies city-wide. AB 2097 prohibits a public agency from imposing or enforcing any minimum parking requirements on a residential, commercial, or other development project located within one-half mile from a public transit stop. The Metrolink Station is currently the only qualified public transit stop within the City. The Planning Commission will receive and file an informational report from the Director of Community Development describing AB 2097 and its impacts on the City.
