Subject: Adopt a Resolution Exonerating Warranty Securities – Awning Recover and New Installation for the Corp Yard, AS-2021-20

BACKGROUND

On September 28, 2022, the City Council accepted the public improvements and warranty securities for the Awning Recover and New Installation for the Corp Yard. Work was performed by Universal Awning & Shade, Inc.

DISCUSSION

Lexington National Insurance Corporation Performance/Payment Bonds No. L265048-2127 in the amount of \$87,368.75 have been held for the required maintenance period and may be exonerated.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no budget impact as a result of this action.

CEQA DETERMINATIONS
